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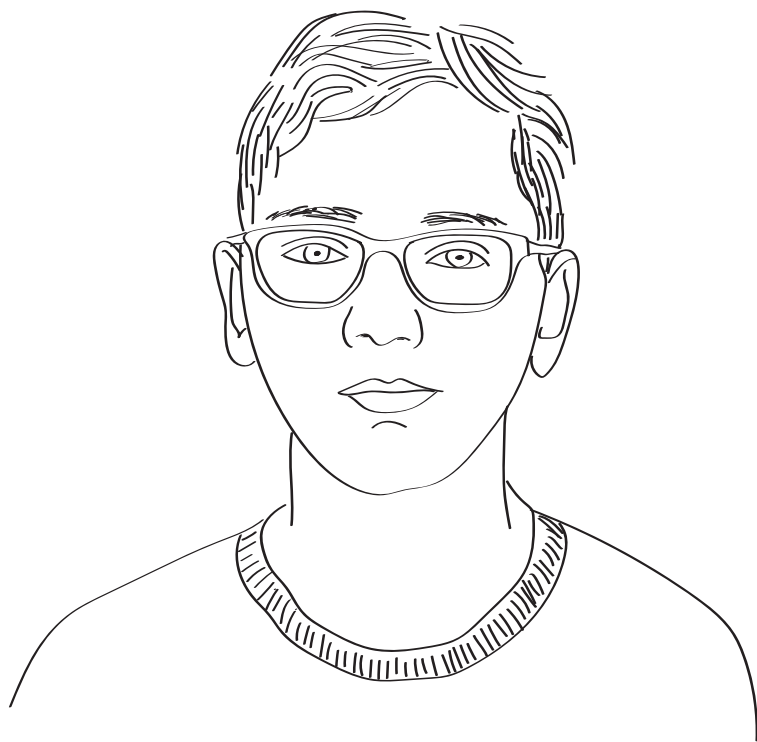

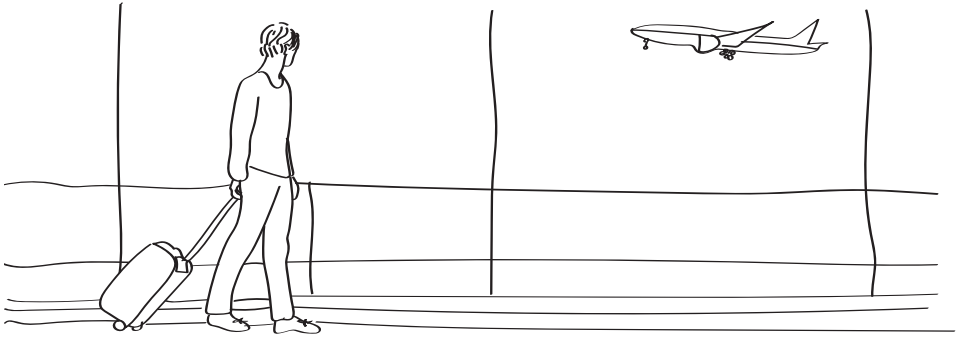

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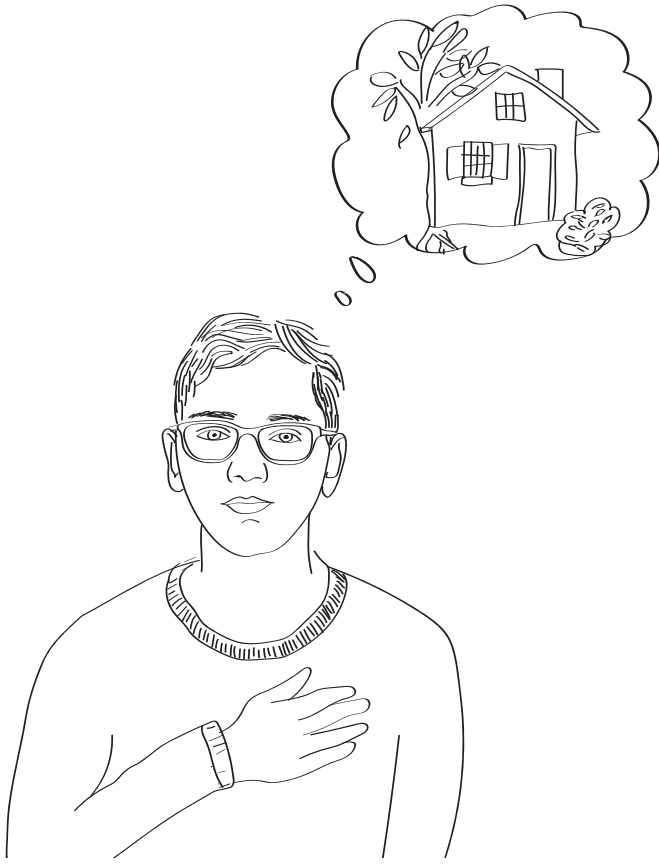
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This is Milad.



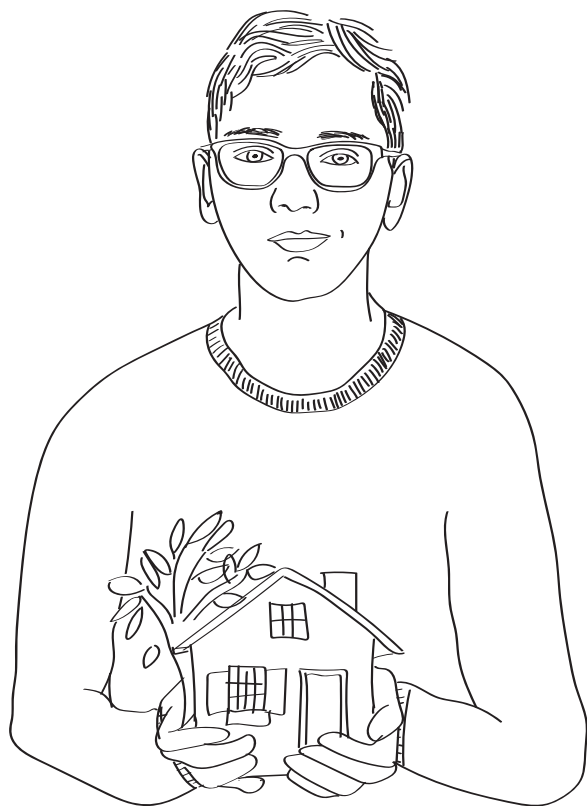
He moves to a new country.



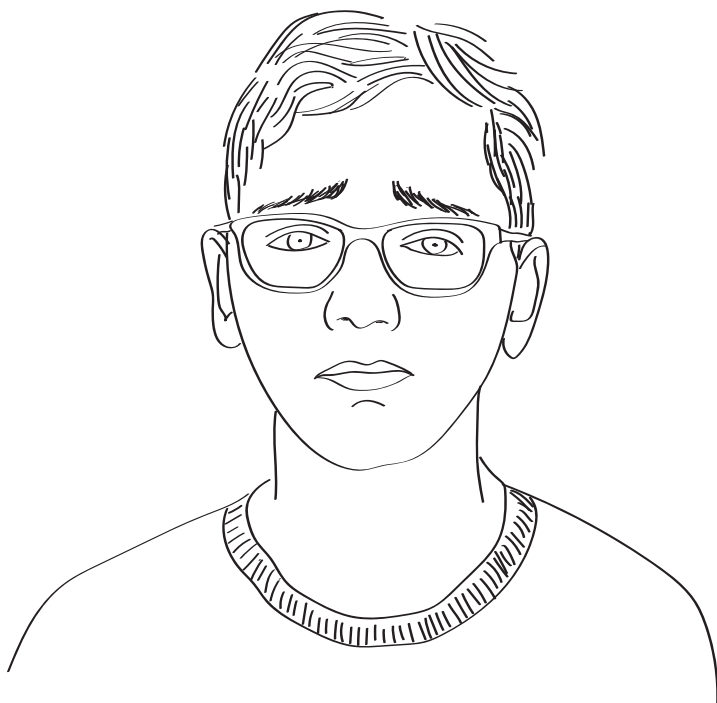
Milad loves his new home.

But Milad is sad.



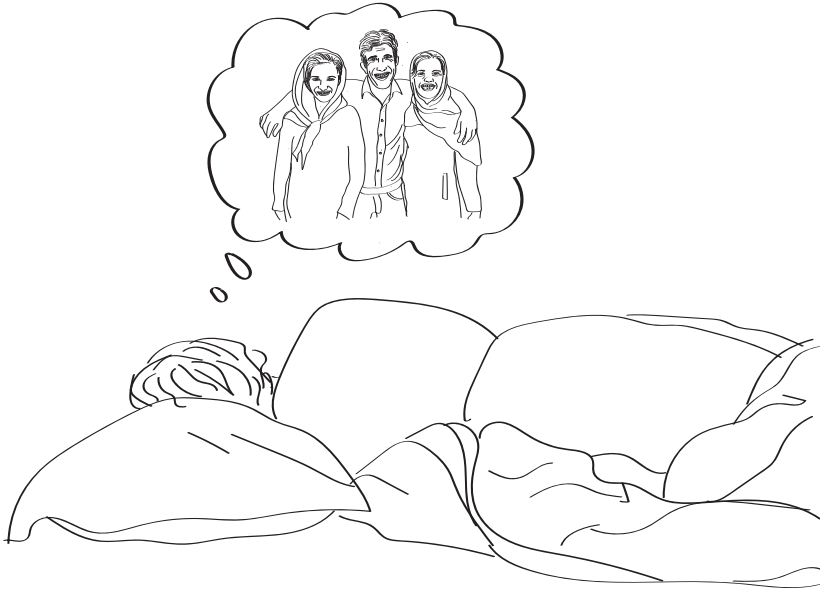
He misses his family back home.



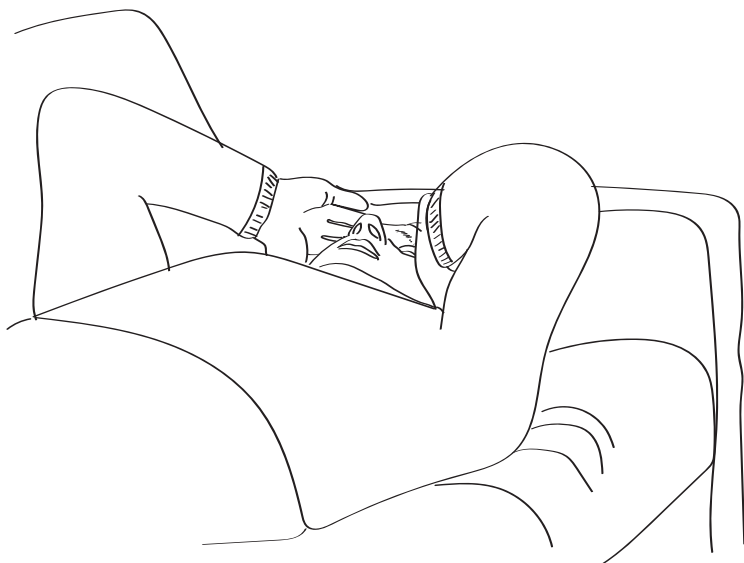
He does not know anyone

It is hard to make friends.



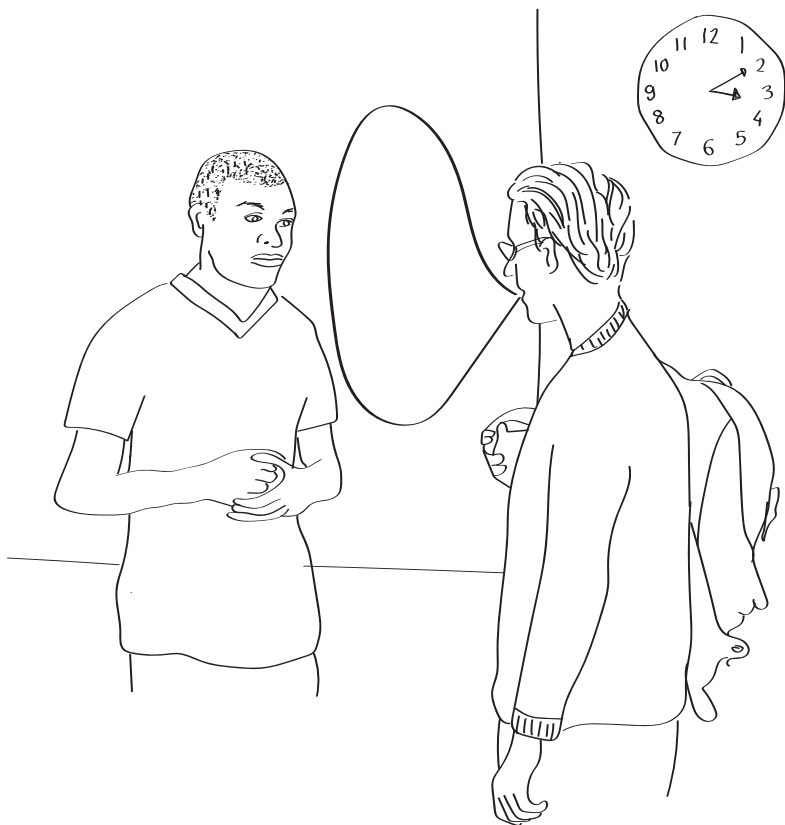
Milad stays at home a lot.

Milad talks to Amadi.



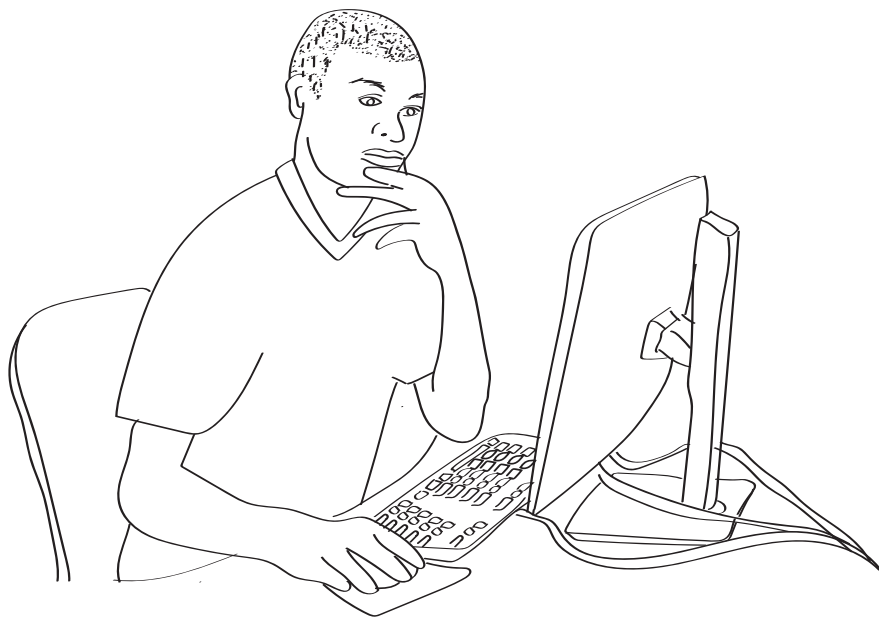
“What do you do after English class?”

“I go to classes.”



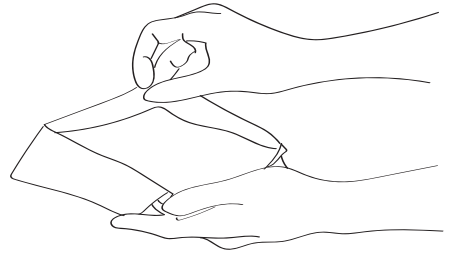
Milad goes to the library

“What is your name and address?”



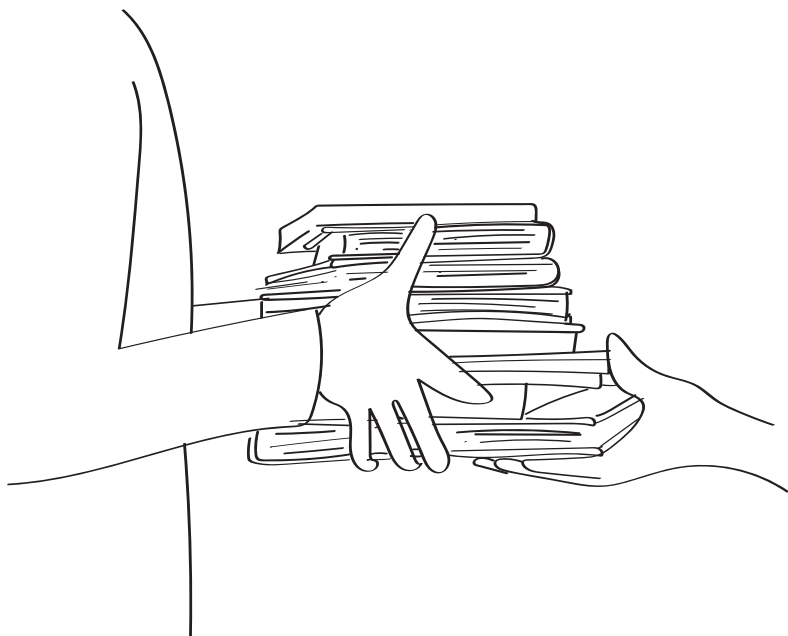
